Hellens Manor

One of the oldest dwellings in England dating to the Domesday Book, the romantic gardens include a rare 17C dovecot, labyrinth and woodland. *Open April to October*



Hergest Croft Gardens

Over 70 acres of gardens with over 5000 rare trees and shrubs, Hergest is one of the finest collections in the British Isles. There is a café too with delicious food. *Open Spring & Summer*



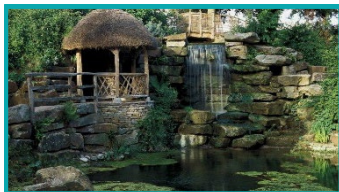
Brobury House Gardens

Open 12 months of the year. Enjoy tranquility through the seasons, terraced on the banks of the River Wye with vistas of the surrounding countryside. There is also a café. *Open all year-round*



Hereford Cathedral

Six acres of layered gardens reflecting ecclesiastical and medicinal themes in the Cloisters Garden, along with beautiful views of the River Wye and Cathedral. *Open Spring & Summer*



Hampton Court Castle

Stroll along the river walk or revel in the symmetry of the Dutch garden, rose terraces, abundant kitchen garden and sunken pools. Walk under the exotic water garden and play in the maze of 1000 yew trees. There is a cafe too. *Open from April*



Westonbury Mill Water Gardens

Home to the largest water-powered cuckoo clock in England, follies, a glass dome made from 5000 bottles and vivid plants, set in 3 acres of streams and ponds. New Paradise and Japanese Gardens and Tea House underway. *Open April to Sept*



Stockton Bury Gardens

40 years of artistic flair has created these family-owned gardens to inspire any enthusiast. Wonder through the secret garden or explore the newly planted pillar garden. Refresh in the Tythe Barn Café. *Open April to October*



Eastnor Castle

Follow the tree trail in the glorious arboretum and around the lake, as well as the beauty of the many plants and trees, which have been raised from seeds imported from all over the world. *Open May to September*



The Laskett Gardens

The largest private formal garden in England, created over 40 years by Sir Roy Strong and his late wife, now belongs to Perennial. Relax in these story-telling grounds. *Open Spring & Summer*



The Weir Garden (NT)

This spectacular riverside garden is owned by The National Trust and sits in a tranquil location with the River Wye meandering through its heart. *Open Spring, Summer & Autumn*

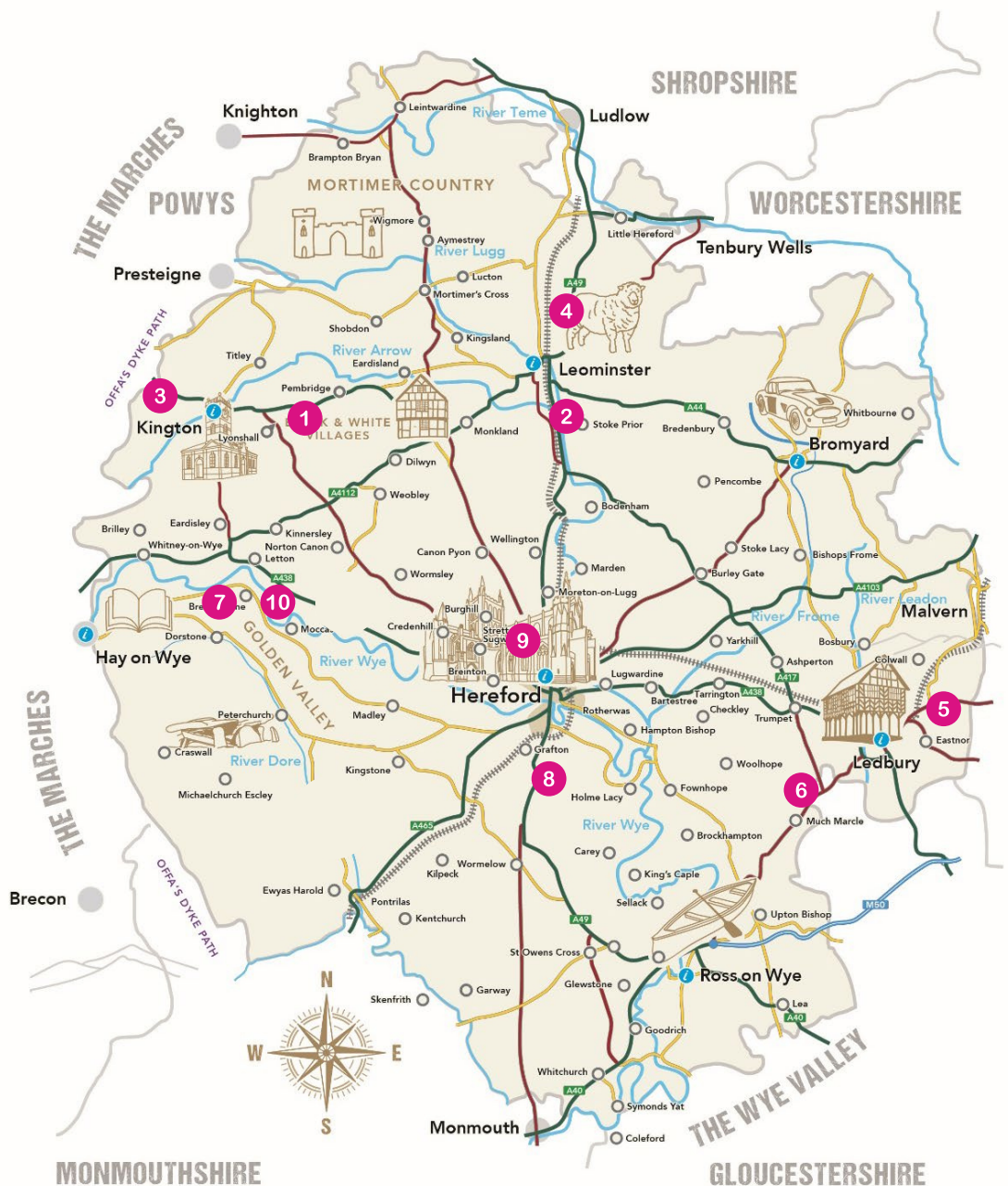
