Hellens Manor

Dating to the Domesday Book and one of the oldest dwellings in England, Hellens sits in Much Marcle near Ledbury. The house is full of haunted rooms, Tudor tales and has a romantic English garden with a rare octagonal dovecot.



Brockhampton Estate (NT)

Located in East Herefordshire, not far from Bromyard, owned by the National Trust, Brockhampton is a traditionally farmed estate and medieval moated manor house offering scenic walks, activities, and historical tours.



Croft Castle (NT)

Sitting in the heart of North Herefordshire countryside, this National Trust property is an ancient castle with parkland, orchards, a walled garden, and a castle steeped in one-thousandyear-old history that includes the War of the Roses.



Hay Castle

A spectacular Castle, with layers of history in its medieval roots to contemporary arts. Recently developed it is now a beacon of art, culture, history, and food at the heart of Hay-on-Wye, the Town of Books.

Exhibitions are held year round and there is a shop and a café.



Eastnor Castle

Near Ledbury, explore theatrically staged stately rooms steeped in history. The trails and walks with spectacular views of Herefordshire are a must. Check for opening dates and annual events, such as the spectacular Chilli Festival and Firework champions.



Berrington Hall (NT)

Created as the perfect house in the perfect setting, Berrington Hall sits majestically in North Herefordshire and is owned by The National Trust. The house has many secrets to uncover as well as the Capability Brown landscaped gardens and lake.



Ludiow Castle

Ludlow Castle is one of the finest medieval ruins in England. Set in the glorious Shropshire countryside at the heart of the bustling black & white market town of Ludlow. The castle boasts an art gallery, café and hosts big name concerts anually.



Hampton Court Castle

A 15C Grade 1 listed castle in the very heart of Herefordshire countryside, close to Leominster. State rooms, a ballroom and individually designed gardens and maze await you. Visitors can delight in lunch in the Joseph Paxton designed Orangery Café.


