Take your group on a guided tour of the historic City of Hereford with the Hereford Guild of Guides. Steeped in history there really is no better way to see Hereford.



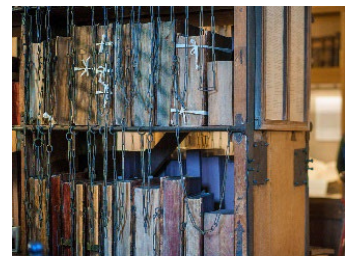
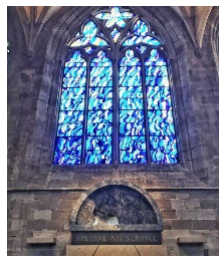
Hereford City Heritage & Civic Museum

The Town Hall, houses Hereford's historic silver and ancient charters that made the town a city, as well as many other artifacts. *The city Library is currently housed inside Hereford Town Hall too.*



Black & White House Museum

Depicting Jacobean life, the Museum gives visitors the chance to immerse themselves in 17C with hands on activities, replica clothing and interactive puzzles.



Hereford Cathedral

Hereford Cathedral contains some of the finest examples of art and architecture from Norman times to the present day, including the famous Mappa Mundi, the medieval Chained Library and the Hereford Magna Carta, as well as the Ascension window and sculpture, built in 2016, commemorating 75 years of the foundation of the SAS in 1941. During the Spring and Summer months, the cathedral gardens are open for carpets of flowers, interesting borders and many plants reflecting ecclesiastical themes and all with beautiful views of the river Wye.
